



# SEA Plein Air Painting/Drawing Event

Monday 21<sup>st</sup> November 2016 Commencing at 10am

Have your work framed and exhibited in the SEA Horse in Art Exhibition 2016!

**Rules.** Meet at the Mews at Palace House, Palace Street, Newmarket, CB8 8EP for 10.00am. Please register on your arrival. Registration costs £10 per support.

You will be provided with a marked 30cm x 30cm canvas board. You may bring a 30cm x 30cm support of your own choosing if you wish but it will need to be marked on the reverse so as to confirm that the work is produced during the competition period. Watercolour paper and cartridge paper will also be available, but please stick to the size format to facilitate framing, as a frame will be provided free of charge for the winning picture. Work must only be made on the day and from life. Work may be in oils, acrylic, pencil, pastels or charcoal etc.

You may wish to bring acrylic colours for toning your ground ahead of starting work.

\* Your subject must be within Newmarket and the gallops. Please be very aware that when painting you are doing so entirely at your own risk. **Please respect the nature of this environment. – There are going to be members of the public and horses nearby.** Many people will be conducting business in the town as this is Sales Week at Tattersalls, and artists **must not obstruct** the use of paths, rights of way etc. *The SEA does not accept any liability for accidents or upset caused by artists who are taking part in the event.* Please do not take any action liable to bring the reputation of the Society into disrepute. We would like to be able to hold more events and the co-operation of the people of Newmarket is paramount. Please be particularly careful on the Warren Hill Gallops and respect the rules there. Horses always take priority and you must avoid spooking them.

Always ask permission to paint where relevant and please keep your set up to an absolute minimum to avoid inconvenience to the public. Registration and signature of this document implies your acceptance of the rules.

Work must be returned to the Mews by 4pm latest.

**You are invited to return at 6pm to discover if your picture has been hung in the exhibition.** (All entrants other than the winner may take their pictures away at 6pm)
